I am writing to you as chair designate for the forthcoming administrative year of Future Oxfordshire Partnership (FOP).

As the leaders of Oxfordshire's councils, we have collectively agreed that given the Housing and Growth Deal is concluding this is the opportunity to do a comprehensive review of FOP, its remit and its governance.

I welcome the proposed "summit" for us as Leaders of Oxfordshire's councils to discuss the future of FOP on 29 July 2024.

This is an important opportunity for us as councils to determine what the role of FOP should be and to define its role and governance.
